I hope this finds y'all well and looking forward to a great Moose year. I would like to start by saying thanks to all the board of officers and chair people who served on the 2025-2026 board. I'd also like to welcome the 2026-2027 board of officers and chair people. Last year we donated a lot of meals for first responders, we look forward to continuing this tradition. May 30th we'll be doing a brat fry for first responders. I've worked this event since it started and looking forward to hosting it.

On a serious note.

As most of you know we have a few service dogs/service dogs in training that come to the lodge. There is a few things I to need to point out. While the dogs may be cute and adorable, they are working. If you see one and want to pet it or acknowledge the dog, please ask the handler first and wait for an answer. Also do not distract the dog, again they are working. Distracting them could cause harm to the handler. I'll use my service dog in training, Panzer as an example. As most of you know and those who don't know, I'm a severe type 1 diabetic. My blood sugar can and has dropped extremely quick with no warning. I can be talking to you and then be unconscious on the floor. He is being trained to alert me and others of my blood sugar level dropping. He does this by either nudging my face to alert me or barking to alert others. This has been witnessed by others. If he is distracted, he may not be able to alert in time. For a diabetic this could result in an injury, coma or death. For some people they are just a dog, for the handlers they are our guardian angels. I sleep better at night knowing he is working. For all service dogs and service dogs in training. Please be respectful, ask before petting and don't distract.
